
WHERE ART AND LIFE UNITE

FRONT TERRACE



2200 square feet | capacity: 200

Step out onto the terrace, an elevated outdoor space offering a breath of fresh air and stunning views of the museum and toward the sea. Seamlessly connected to the Lobby through retractable doors, this area creates a large indoor/outdoor setting perfect for mingling and celebration.


The terrace features the Arcade, a charming walkway adorned with picturesque arches, ideal for memorable photo opportunities. Its slight separation from the main event area provides a unique, more private retreat for guests to enjoy.

You can use the wall as a dynamic canvas for digital art, adding a unique and visually captivating element that enhances your event's aesthetics. Whether you choose to keep the area open for mingling and movement or arrange tables for a more structured setup, the terrace adapts effortlessly to your needs to create the perfect atmosphere for your event.

FIRST FLOOR LOBBY

988 square feet | 150 capacity

Our versatile lobby, is a spacious and flexible area designed to adapt to your event needs. Retractable doors on either side open to reveal even more options, stacking neatly on the right, left, or center. Multiple ceiling speakers allow for seamless integration with our rentable cordless mic or your own music playlist, ensuring your event sounds as great as it looks.



FRONT TERRACE & FIRST FLOOR LOBBY


3,188 square feet | 350 capacity

MILLENNIUM CLUB ROOM

432 square feet capacity: 15 seated, 25 standing

Discover the Millennium Club Room, an intimate meeting room equipped with a projector and video conferencing tools. This room accommodates up to 15 people comfortably and features a refrigerator, sink, and microwave -making lunch meetings a breeze!

This space can double as a bridal suite with full-length mirrors and ample natural light, making it ideal for pre-event preparation. Additionally, it functions as a production and storage area during events, offering convenience and efficiency for event organizers.

Venue Rental FAQ's

DOES OMA PROVIDE CATERING SERVICES?

Our specialty is showcasing Southern California artists, so we leave the food art to the professionals. To help you get started, we have a list of preferred caterers to choose from that have the required licensing and already know their way around our museum space and well-equipped kitchen. If you have your own caterer preselected, no problem! We just require a walkthrough with your selected caterer in advance along with proof of their appropriate food service license and liquor license if alcohol is being served. If interested in having a food truck for your special event, please inquire.

IS THERE PARKING AVAILABLE?

There is free street parking around the museum, including the Civic Center parking garage. Street parking may be impacted during Thursday markets and other local festivals. A great resource to check out is <u>visitoceanside.org/events/</u> for information on any happenings in the area that could impact parking availability.

DO YOU HAVE FURNITURE AVAILABLE?

Yes, OMA has tables, chairs, AV equipment and more available for rent. Please request a copy of our equipment rental sheet for a full inventory list and pricing.

DO I NEED TO HAVE AN EVENT PLANNER?

The short answer is yes. Since we do not provide event planning services, OMA will need one point person to organize your event from start to finish. Often this person will also be your onsite day-of coordinator who will be responsible for managing all vendors and being OMA's point of contact.

In the case of weddings, OMA requires wedding clients to have an event planner or dedicated point person who is not in the bridal party. Wedding clients must have a reliable day-of, on-site contact managing vendors, load-in, schedule, and guests so our Brides and Grooms (and their parents) can relax and know they are in good hands.

Venue Rental FAQ's

CAN WE START OUR EVENT BEFORE 5:00PM?

At OMA, we consider the start of your event when your guests arrive. Because we are open to the public until 5:00pm most days, we want to make sure our ticketed museum guests' experience is not disrupted by a private event and vice versa. We offer one hour of additional set up beginning at 4:00pm, while our museum is still open. If you would like your event to start earlier than 5:00pm, please inquire about our early closure fee. If you would like to have your event during the day, you may want to consider a Monday or Tuesday, when OMA is closed to the public.

CAN I BOOK AN EVENT THAT IS OVER 5 HOURS LONG?

Of course! If necessary, an early museum closure fee or additional hour/s can be applied to your base rental fee. Event times must be confirmed prior to the signing of the contract. Changes can be negotiated and noted in an addendum if necessary. Any events that last longer than the stated and agreed-upon rental times will automatically be charged an overtime fee.

HOW LATE CAN WE PLAY MUSIC?

The City of Oceanside has a 10:00pm Sound Ordinance, therefore all <u>outdoor</u> music must be turned off at 10:00pm.

DO OUR GUESTS HAVE ACCESS TO THE GALLERIES?

When renting the entire museum, your guests will have access to all of our currently installed exhibitions throughout your event. Please check with us to see which exhibitions will be up at the time of your event. OMA frequently changes its exhibitions, so a gallery may be closed for installation at the time of your event. If you are renting a portion of the museum, you will have access to select exhibitions adjacent to your event space. Additional staff can be hired at a cost to have access to all galleries without the entire museum rental. No food/drinks are allowed in the galleries at any time. OMA will have tables at the entrance of each gallery that your guests can place their drinks on prior to enjoying the art.
